## THE HOT WATER TREATMENT CATALOG

The picture below shows what eelworm infection looks like among three year old seedlings. You can see it has gradually spread through one box and is threatening the next.

Last season was unusually perfect so the early die off that can indicate a problem was very apparent. Most seasons everything dies off early and quickly and this kind of infection is not obvious until the following season when fewer things sprout.



I am hopeful that I have not spread this problem to anyone else. I have always tried to distribute perfectly healthy bulbs. The worst risk is those varieties that are resistant because they can look healthy and remain infectious for longer. I am confident that bulbs distributed last year were not infected because they have shown no infection here this year, but growers should be watchful. If bulbs from earlier years were infected I expect they will have disappeared. If this is suspected it is wise not to plant bulbs in the same place for a number of years.

Eelworm is a common problem and commercial growers routinely hot water treat their bulbs. This is something I will now have to do for the foreseeable future. The problem got quickly out of hand here because I reused and mixed infected soil when replanting bulbs, thinking the problem was basal rot. As a rule I welcome diseases that kill weaker bulbs.

This year my Canberra stock was lifted and hot water treated for three hours at 45C with a three hour 30C pre-treatment. After a couple of months in storage the bulbs appear to be in good condition and free of infection.

As an extra precaution the bulbs offered in this catalog are from stock that showed no infection and were heat treated separately. The heat treatment means the bulbs may not flower normally in their first season.

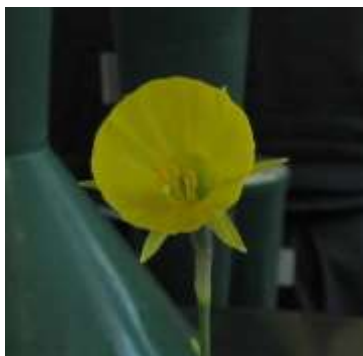

'Winter Colors' is a name for a genetically diverse range of hardy bulbocodiums in a variety of colors from white to yellow, with flowering times that range from late autumn through to spring. Flowering times can be quite variable from year to year.

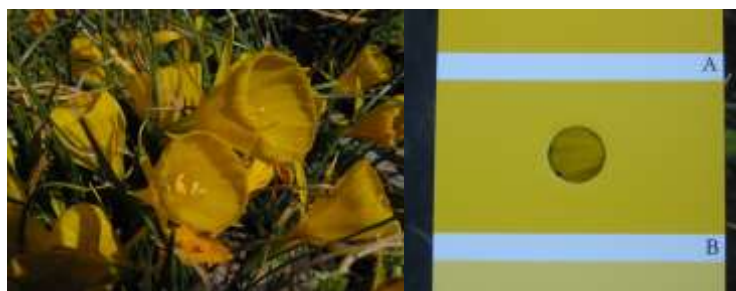

## INTERSECTIONAL BULBOCODIUM HYBRIDS

### Gold Step 10Y-Y



This is an astonishingly vigorous inter-sectional bulbocodium hybrid that has proven itself to be a parent of vigorous seedlings. To my knowledge, this is the first fertile hybrid of its type. It's classification as division 10 is correct I think, but it is NOT a miniature.

## TAZETTAS

- called 'Jonquils' by florists

### First Stanza 8W-O



This is one of the most remarkable of tazettas. It is one of the very first daffodils to flower in the autumn, flowering within weeks of a cool wet change - and can be forced to flower even earlier by putting it in the shade and watering it. It has scent that may be pleasant even to those who dislike tazettas. It is outstandingly floriferous and an outstanding increaser with almost every offset producing a stem of flowers. It may prove to be one of the few daffodils that succeed on the coast

## JONQUILS – PUTATIVE TETRAPLOIDS

### Fourquil Late ( grex of 01\_04J; 01\_05J) tetraploid jonquilla



These siblings were bred from putative artificial tetraploid jonquillas and are almost certainly tetraploid. They are obviously pollen fertile and have produced fertile intersectional hybrids both as seed and pollen parents but, unlike diploid *N. jonquilla*, they parent very reluctantly. Worth persisting with I think but be prepared for disappointment.

### Fourquil Erli (grex of 10 Fourquil Late x *N. fernandesii*)



These are 01\_04J x *N. fernandesii* (MS449) or similar. They can produce long foliage in autumn and flower early mid-winter depending on temperature and moisture.

Like Fourquil Late these flowers are also reluctant parents.

## EARLY JONQUILLA

### Winter Satin (11\_01J) 7Y-Y



This flower is an op of an op of Bill Welch's (N. jonquilla v. henriquesii x Early Louisiana). It has flowered as early as May/June and is probably the flower of choice for early jonquilla.
